



#### HURRICANE HARVEY

Causing damages estimated at more than \$125B, Hurricane Harvey created long term needs for home repairs and rebuilds across our community. By making our full inventory available at no cost to responding nonprofits, the ToolBank has supported 5,008 projects supporting those impacted by Hurricane Harvey.

#### ... UNTIL ALL WORK IS DONE

The effects of disaster events are longlasting and varied, which is why we share all critical recovery tools at no cost until every last person is recovered, no matter how long it takes.

#### COVID-19

When our community was faced by the COVID-19 pandemic all community projects immediately cancelled. In response, we shifted our model from tool lending to resource distribution. We received and distributed large quantities of masks, hand sanitizer and other critical PPE items necessary to keep our community safe. The Houston ToolBank's proactive approach
to disaster preparedness makes them an
invaluable asset to our community. By
fostering collaboration and sharing best
practices, the ToolBank helps build resilience
and fortify our community's capacity to
withstand and recover from disasters.

# NEIGHBORHOOD TOOL HUBS AND DELIVERY

This program, implemented in 2021, expands accessibility of our shared inventory beyond central Houston, allowing partners to pickup from the Hub closest to their location, or receive delivery directly to their door. Our Hubs are located in: Angleton, Beaumont, City Center, Conroe, Galveston and Richmond.

I appreciate the system of delivering tools to the City Center Neighborhood Tool Hub. At the age of 80, I did not relish driving a big rental truck back and forth on a busy I-10, and now, I do not have to worry.

Doug Smith, Alief Super Neighborhood 25 ... since 2021, has borrowed 2,965 tools in support of 22 projects saving \$59,372!

We know that we all learn differently, but when you use hands-on teaching methods the impact is long lasting. Our students came away from Tool School with much more confidence and competence using various tools, especially power saws, drills and impact drivers.

Tool School builds trainee confidence, independence, and develops passion for skills connected to trade sector employment.
